I. FINAL DECISION – Compliance with Land and Groundwater Use Restrictions

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that the implementation of the institutional controls that require compliance with land and groundwater use restrictions will be the Final Remedy required for the Former Eltra Corporation facility located at 4700 N. 5th Street Highway, Temple, Pennsylvania 19560 (Facility). This determination is based on EPA's findings as detailed in the Statement of Basis (SB).

II. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

On May 23rd, 2017, EPA proposed a determination of compliance with land and groundwater use restrictions designed to minimize the potential for human exposure to contamination remaining in soil and groundwater at the Facility. Consistent with public participation provisions under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), EPA requested comments from the public on the proposed remedy as described in the SB. The commencement of a thirty (30)-day public comment period was announced in Reading Eagle Co. newspaper on May 23rd, 2017 and on the EPA Region III website. The public comment period ended on June 22nd, 2017.

III. RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

EPA received no comments on the proposal. Consequently, EPA's final determination is unchanged from the proposal.

IV. AUTHORITY

EPA is issuing this Final Decision under the authority of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by RCRA, and the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984, 42 U.S.C. Sections 6901 to 6992k.

V. DECLARATION

Based on the Administrative Record compiled for the Corrective Action at the Former Eltra Corporation facility, EPA has determined that the Final Remedy selected in this Final Decision and Response to Comments is protective of human health and the environment.
