


Using Zoom

The Zoom menu bar appears at the bottom of the Zoom window once the meeting begins. If you don't see the menu bar, move your mouse slightly and the bar should appear.






Using Zoom – Renaming Yourself

- 1. To change your name, click on "Participants".
- 2. The Participants list will pop out.
- 3. Toggle over your name.
- 4. Options will appear. Select **more** and then select **rename**.
- 5. You will see another popup. Enter your name and click **"OK"**


Center navigation bar links contain the 3 main search methods:




Bottom navigation bar links:

New users should begin by creating an account using the Create Account link.




Water Finance Clearinghouse User Accounts

Water Finance Clearinghouse User Accounts


General Users

Contributors

- Suggest edits to existing information
- Suggest new content
- Suggest removal of content
- Schedule reminder emails for easy content management
- Favorite Resources and Funding sources
- Subscribe to email updates

Contributor Account Benefits




General User resource suggestions are limited to providing a URL and comments.


Contributors are individuals who represent entities that routinely publish or produce water finance-specific resources and/or those that manage water funding sources.

Contributor Benefits:


- Resource Suggestions options are more detailed (See Suggesting a Resource or Funding Source section)
- Can be saved as draft and return to suggestions later
- Contributors can monitor the status of their suggestion












Contributor Portal Exports

Contributors can generate reports using Suggestions, Resources, and Funds content tables.




Altering Reports

Reports and lists can be modified with the "Actions" menu.


