



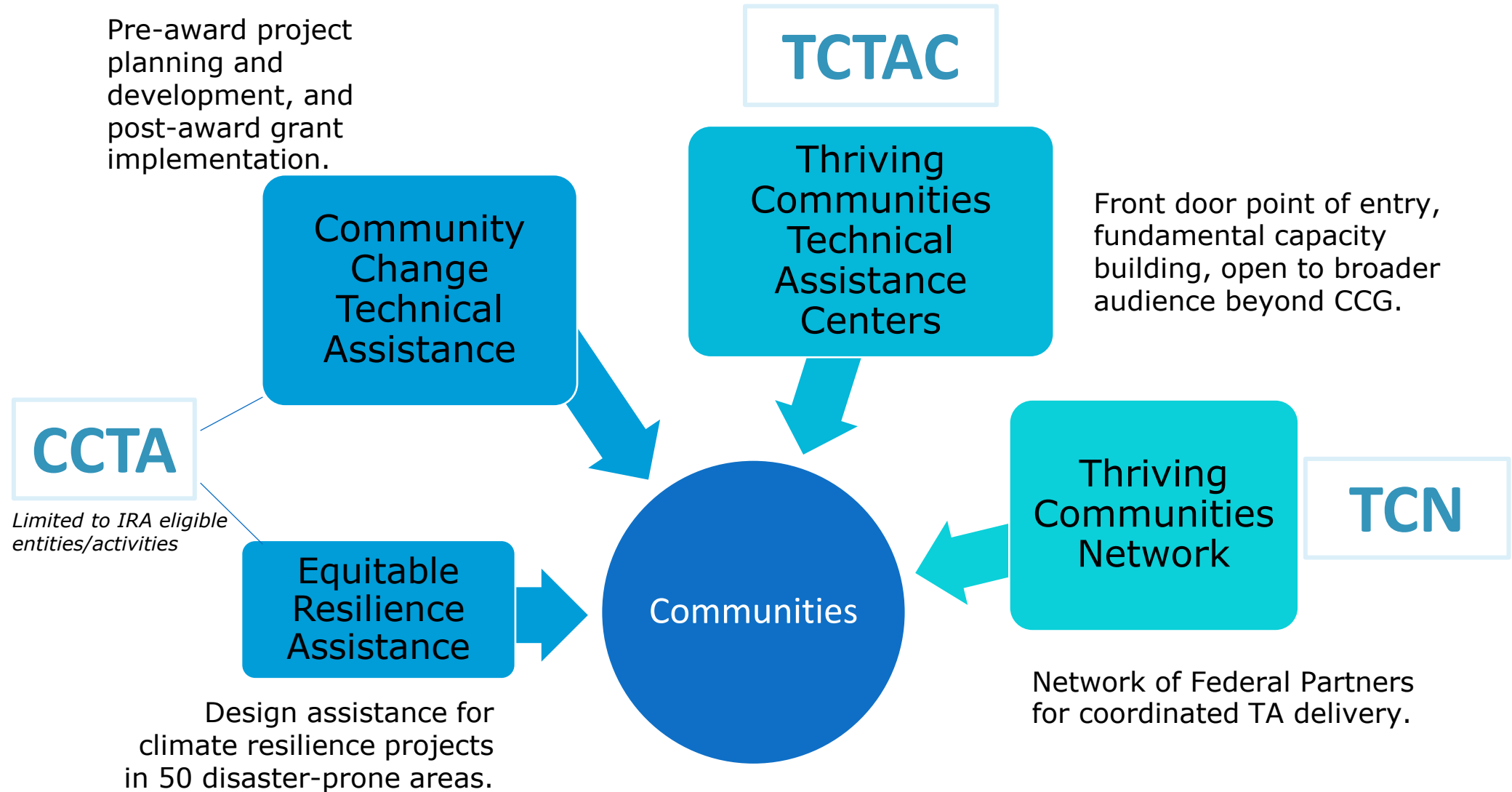

OEJECR Technical Assistance Efforts



Community Change Technical Assistance (CCTA) Program



- \$200M from IRA to fund Technical Assistance (TA)
- 2 TA Programs: CCTA and Community Change Equitable Resilience TA (CCER TA)
- Supports \$2B IRA funded Community Change Grants
- Funds available ***until September 30, 2026***
- TA launched on November 21, 2023 simultaneously w/Community Change Grant NOFO

CCTA

- TA delivery on a first come, first served basis
- TA project must benefit disadvantaged communities
- TA requestor must intend to apply to Community Change Grants
- Community access to CCTA provider directly via on-line TA Request Form

CCTA

Eligible Entities (from IRA legislation)

(1) a partnership between two community-based nonprofit organizations (CBOs)

OR

(2) a partnership between a CBO and one of the following:

- federally recognized tribe
- local government
- institution of higher education

CCTA

Eligible Activities (from IRA legislation)

- Climate resilience and adaptation (including but not limited to community greening, stormwater management, mobility, energy efficiency, waste reduction, brownfields redevelopment projects).
- Pollution reduction (including but not limited to indoor/outdoor air quality, toxic remediation, clean water infrastructure, waste, and pollution monitoring projects).
- Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) pollution remediation projects.
- Workforce development that supports the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and other air pollutants, and other environmental economic projects.
- Facilitating the engagement of disadvantaged communities in State and Federal advisory groups, workshops, rulemakings, and other public processes.

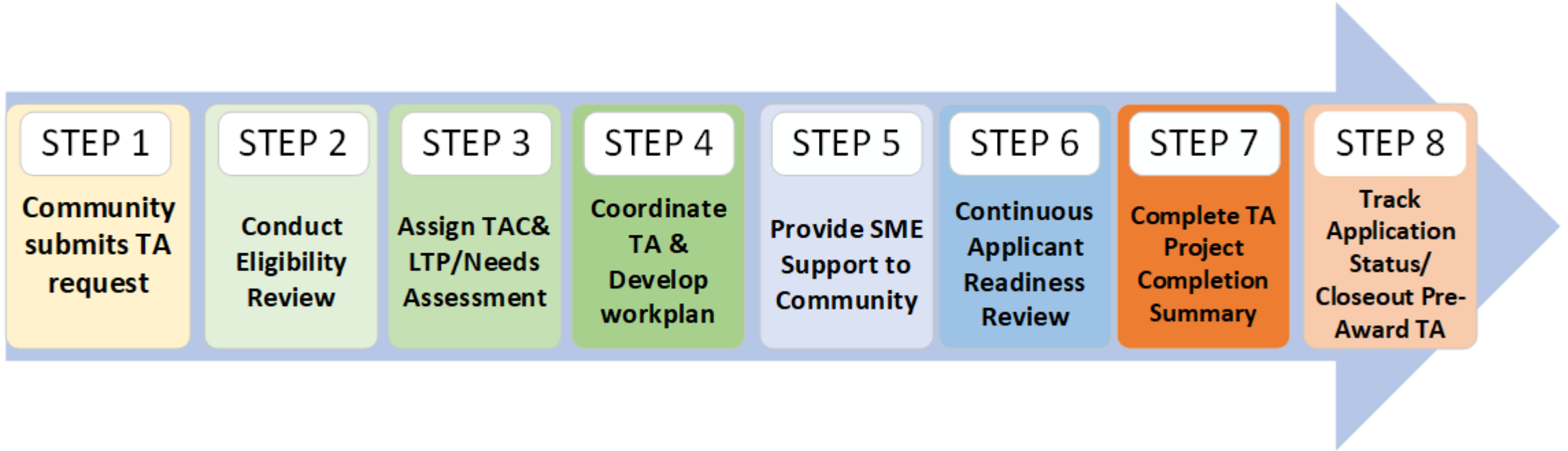
