

RFQ for LFG Energy Project at Bees Ferry Landfill, SC



As a service to our Partners and other interested parties, EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is sharing information about a **request for qualifications (RFQ)** from the **County of Charleston, South Carolina**. Please note that EPA is not affiliated in any way with the review and selection process. Information provided is based on the RFQ.

The County of Charleston is requesting **statements of qualifications** from offerors with proven experience and expertise that are interested in **developing a landfill gas (LFG) energy project for commercial and beneficial use of LFG at the Bees Ferry Landfill**. The County will evaluate and score the statements of qualifications submitted, with the intent of inviting the best qualified offerors to respond to a future request for proposals.

The scope of services for an LFG energy project will include planning, permitting, financing, design, construction, operation, maintenance, and environmental monitoring services, as well as the marketing, sale, and distribution of the LFG's full market value.
