The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) has identified additional information or clarification needed for continued evaluation of the subject permit application. The comments are included in three Enclosures to this letter: Evaluation of CTV's Responses to EPA's Comments on Site Characterization, Evaluation of CTV III Project Plans, and Evaluation of CTV III Project Financial Responsibility Information. Note that project plans evaluated include the well operation plan, well corrective action plan, well testing and monitoring plan, post-injection site care and site closure plan, emergency and remedial response plan, well construction and plugging plan, and pre-operational testing plan. Also note that the evaluation of the project financial responsibility information enclosure contains certain information claimed as confidential by CTV and will be provided to CTV separately in a secure way that CTV agreed upon.

Please submit the information requested in the Enclosures by December 2, 2024. If additional time is needed to respond, CTV should submit to EPA a written request for extension that provides a proposed alternative due date and a justification for the time extension.
